The Mexican Childhood Cancer Association (AMANC) was founded in 1982 by Mrs. Maria Guadalupe Alejandre, as a response to the hospital deficiencies faced by the Mexican families that have children and teenagers with cancer.

Mrs. Alejandre learned about these challenges from her son Pablo, who was unable to overcome leukemia at the age of 8.

Since then, AMANC has become the first institution in Mexico to provide free and complete support to children and teenagers with cancer throughout their treatments.

This site, built exclusively to provide social and psychosocial support for high socially vulnerable children and their families, is located in Tlalpan, within the hospital area situated in the south of Mexico City. It has the capacity to offer temporary stay for a maximum of 50 children accompanied by a family member, most of them coming from the rest of the country.

As well, the AMANC Center has a specialized bone marrow transplant recovery area, unique in the country, and offers open spaces for recreational, educational and productive activities in a comfortable and loving environment.




# Fit spaces for recovery
